I was born in London.

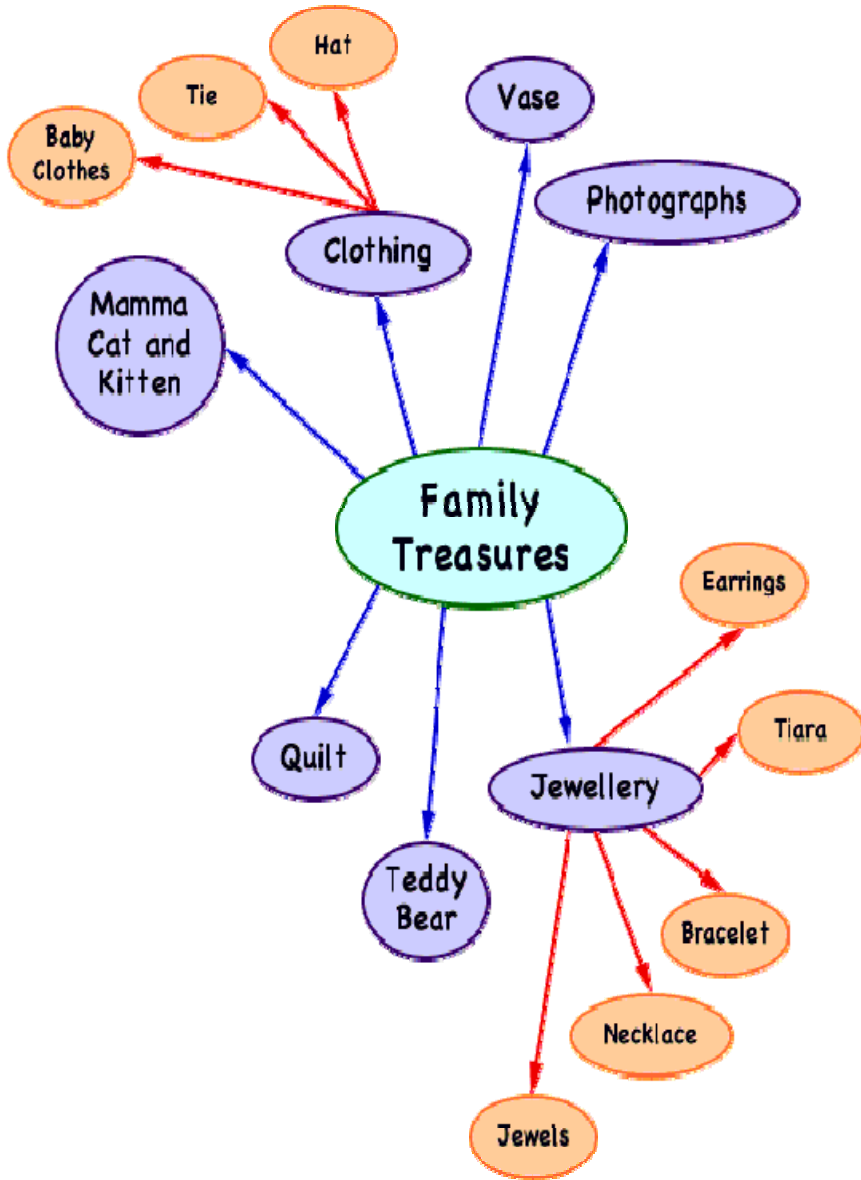
My family comes from Lebanon.

My family treasure is a silver necklace. The charm shows Lebanon, and is shaped like the country.



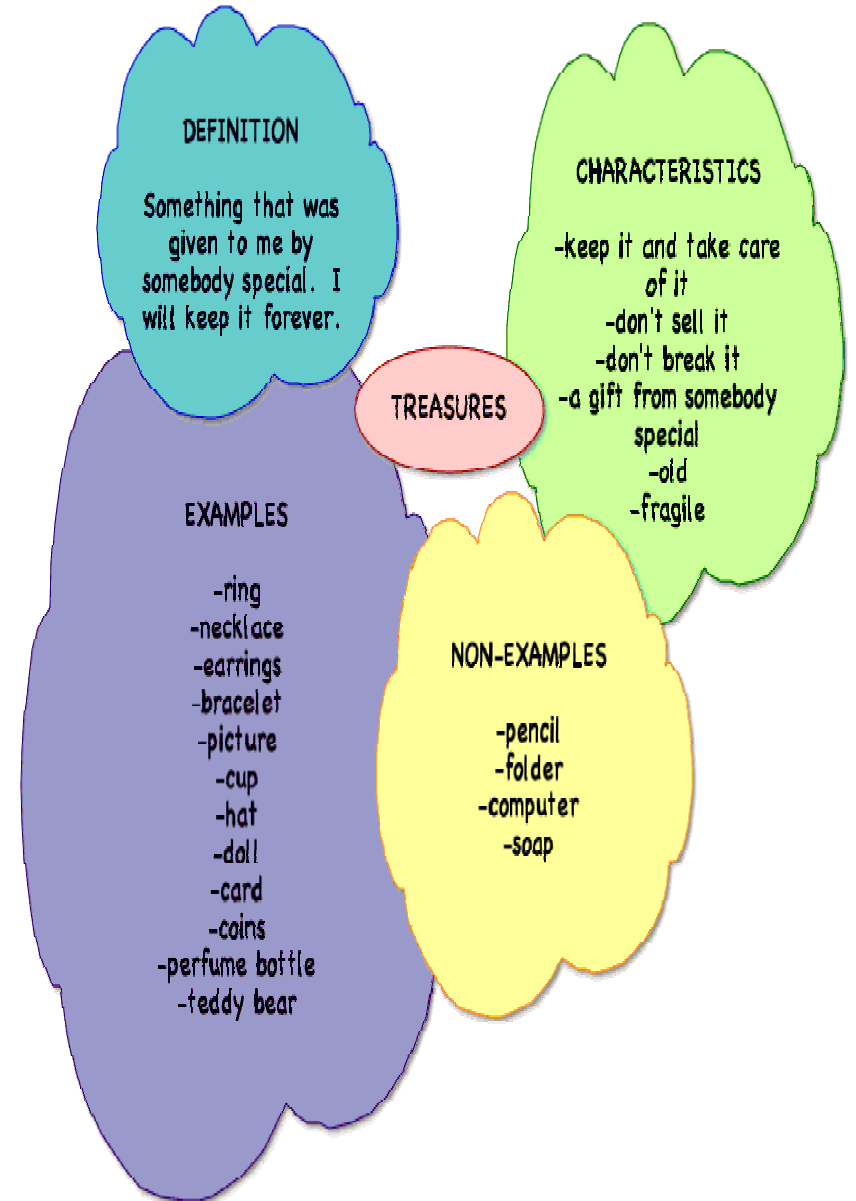

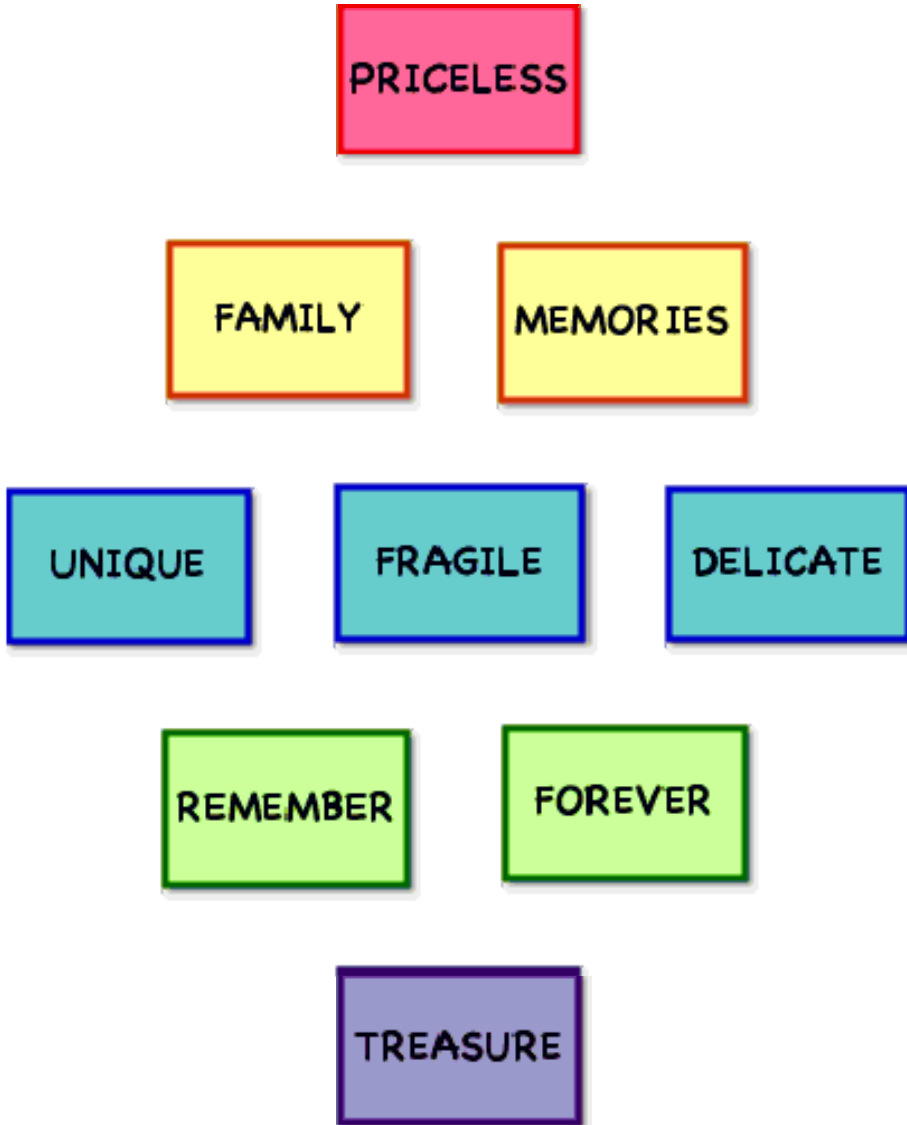

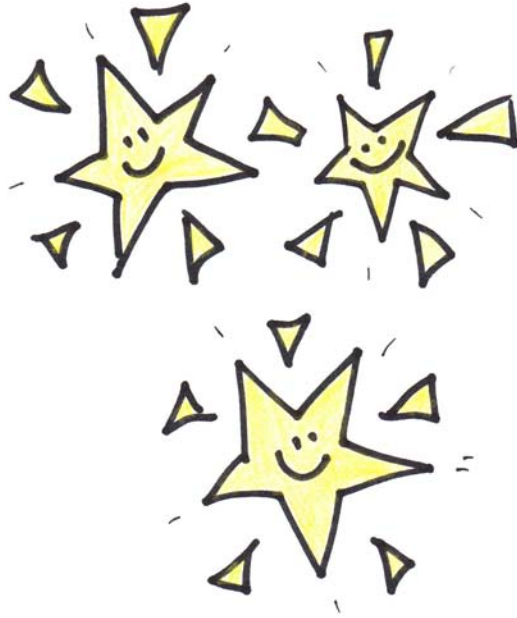


The charm comes from Lebanon. It shows my family's country, Lebanon. It has a picture of a cedar tree on it.
